
Dear Friend,

I am proud to announce, in conjunction with the Union City Police Department, the State Department of Alcoholic Beverage Commission, and most importantly you, we've rid our city of numerous liquor establishments. Once a license is revoked or purchased by the City, the license is forever retired and cannot be issued again.

Union City, on a daily basis, makes certain that all liquor establishments follow the law and local ordinances by doing bar checks and responding to your complaints.

Years ago, the Commissioners and I reduced the operating hours of bars and it greatly lessened the number of annual police calls. No residents of our City should not be able to get a good night's sleep or have to deal with fights in the street by intoxicated



parties, just as we cannot tolerate public drinking or urination. Our community, especially our children, deserve better. We want the police

to be there when YOU need them – we don't need our officers to be busy babysitting liquor establishments.

The Commissioners and I are proud to that we have made great strides, but we are far from finished.
