20 there's probably two.

21 MR. FARMER: Yeah, about a half dozen.
22 And Lieutenant Dunlay and myself went over them
23 last week. We have a conference which is going to
24 be a week from this Thursday, we'll probably take
25 care of half of them at least, if not more.

1 MAYOR STACK: Okay, good. Just wanted
2 to get an overview, that's all. Make sure we're
3 staying on top of it.

4 LIEUTENANT DUNLAY: Absolutely.

5 MR. FARMER: If he's not staying on top
6 of it, I'll be the first one to come before this
7 Board and alert you to that fact.

8 MAYOR STACK: Exactly.
