



REQUIREMENTS FOR DEMOLITION OF BUILDINGS

ATTENTION DEMOLITION CONTRACTORS:

In addition to permit applications, the following must be submitted to the **Building Department** as part of the required paperwork prior to issuing a demolition permit.

1. Statement from PSE&G that gas and electric utilities have been cut off.
2. Statement from an exterminator that building has no termites or has been treated for termites and rodents.
3. Statement from Water Company that water service has been shut off.
4. Statement from Sewer Authority confirming notification of demolition.
5. Copies of notice sent to adjacent property owners stating date of construction.
6. Asbestos survey/ letter from an authorized licensed company.
7. Contractor must register with the state.
8. Plumbing permit for capping for sewer.
9. Underground Storage tank certificate of approval of certification from a licensed Environmental company stating that the tank does not exist or require permits/ inspections for removal.
10. Copy of the property survey.
11. Provide verification of Soil Conservation approval for lots greater than 5,000 Sq. Ft. or exemption letter for lots less than 5,000 square feet.
