While the children are out of school, it is important to keep them reading and learning throughout the summer months. The Union City Public Library offers a variety of programs for all ages and interests. It is my hope that everyone finds something to enjoy.

It is also essential to note that the Summer Food Program will start on July 27th at the 43rd Street Branch. Free breakfast and lunch will be provided to the children who participate and their caregivers.

I encourage our senior citizens to participate in "Senior Citizen Hour" at the library. It will be a special time set aside for senior citizens to get together and spend time socializing with their friends and neighbors.

I hope you have a great summer and take advantage of all we have to offer at the Union City Public Library.

WHAT'S NEW?

The library kicks off Summer Programming on July 5th at 2:00 PM with the "Snakes and Scales" show at 43rd Street and "Princess Elsa" show at 1800 Summit Avenue.

Activities for children take place daily and consist of games, arts and crafts, reading, and films. Special presentations will be given throughout the summer in addition to the list of daily activities. The Library will host weekly workshops with NJ visiting children's writers who will read from their books and discuss their experiences as authors. The Union City Police Department will make a presentation on summer safety and with members of the Humane Society will teach children how to tend to their pets. Programs on computer coding and robotics will be provided for those interested in technology and a workshop on henna painting for those who want to pursue their artistic side.

The summer reading program finale takes place on August 10th at 2:00 PM with special shows for the children at both branches and parting gifts for all participants.

Senior Citizen Hour, citizenship classes, knitting, jewelry making and computer classes are just a few of the programs that are offered for adults.

The Summer Food Program will offer breakfast and lunch at the 43rd Street Library beginning on June 27th and lasting the duration of the summer. We offer meals to all participating children, as well as to the parents, or caregivers who accompany them. The library will open its doors to children and parents at 7:30 in the morning, Monday-Friday.

The library has started a "Senior Citizen Hour" every Tuesday at 10:00 A.M. We can show you r favorite movies or just have coffee and conversation. Transportation to the library is provided.
