

Notice to Bidders

Notice is hereby given that sealed proposals will be received by the City of Union City, Hudson County, New Jersey for the 2020 CITY-WIDE TREE PLANTING PROGRAM (Various Locations) and be opened and read in public at the City of Union City, City Hall, 3715 Palisade Avenue, Union City, New Jersey 07087 in the Office of the City Clerk, on Thursday, June 25, 2020 at 11:30 AM, prevailing time.

The project consists of removing and disposing of existing dead trees and stumps in existing tree well as stumps in existing tree wells. The project also consists planting new shade trees with topsoil, watering bags, and granite blocks in existing tree wells. The Project also consists of installing and maintaining traffic control devices for the duration of the project. The City will finalize locations after the award of contract. For bidding purposes, a location table is provided in Appendix "A" of the project specifications.

All work on this contract shall be completed within **thirty (30) calendar days of Notice to Proceed**. The City of Union City will strictly abide by these dates. The contractor will need to provide the appropriate labor force and equipment to comply with the required schedule.

Contract Documents and Drawings for the proposed work, which have been prepared by Ralph J. Tango, Jr., P.E. of the firm Maser Consulting P.A., are available electronically or via delivery by common carrier beginning on Thursday, May 28, 2020 by making a request to **ljboyer@maserconsulting.com**.

Bidders will be furnished with a copy of the Contract Documents by request upon proper notice to the above e-mail address. The bid proposal packages will **not** be available for pickup. In the e-mail message, the contractor shall indicate if they request an electronic copy (PDF format) or paper copy. Electronic copies will be provided via e-mail at no charge. Paper copies will be provided after a non-refundable charge of \$50.00 payable to Maser Consulting P.A. is received. Paper copies will be sent via UPS or FedEx if the contractor provides UPS or FedEx account information to defray the cost of this shipping method. Otherwise, paper copies will be sent via USPS.

Proposals must be made on the standard Proposal forms in the manner designated in the Contract documents, must be enclosed in a sealed envelope, bearing the name and address of the Bidder and the name of the project on the outside, and be addressed to the City Clerk of Union City, and must be accompanied by a Statement of Consent of Surety from a surety company authorized to do business in the State of New Jersey and acceptable to the municipality and either a Bid Bond or a Certified Check, drawn to the order of City of Union City, for not less than ten percent (10%) of the amount bid, except that the check shall not exceed \$20,000.00 The successful bidder is hereby notified that a performance bond and payment bond, for the full amount of this project, and all labor, is required.

The award of the Contract for this project will not be made until the necessary funds have been provided by the City of Union City in a lawful manner.

The City, or the Engineer, reserves the right to require a complete financial and experience statement from prospective bidders showing that they have satisfactorily completed work of the nature required before furnishing proposal forms or specifications, or before awarding the Contract. Proposals for this Contract will only be accepted from bidders who have properly qualified in accordance with the requirements of the Contract documents.

The right is also reserved to reject any or all bids, or to waive any informalities where such informality is not detrimental to the best interest of the City. Further, the City reserves the right to abandon the project and reject the bids entirely if any legal, state or federal administrative action is taken against the City, which could delay or jeopardize the project from commencing. The right is also reserved to increase or decrease the quantities specified in the manner designated in the Specifications.

The successful bidder shall be required to comply with the following:

- A. Affirmative Action requirements (N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. & N.J.A.C. 17:27-1 et seq.).
- B. The provisions of the New Jersey Prevailing Wage Act (N.J.S.A. 34:11-56.25 et seq.).
- C. Anti-Kickback Regulations under Section 2 of the Act of June 13, 1934, known as the Copeland Act.
- D. Worker and Community Right-to-Know Act (N.J.S.A. 34:5A-1).
- E. Anti-Drug/Alcohol plan in accordance with 49 CFR Parts 40, 199 and 391.

The bid must be accompanied by a list of names and addresses of all stockholders owning ten percent (10%) or more of the stock, in accordance with the provisions of the Public Disclosure Law (P.L. 1988, C.33, N.J.S.A. 52:25-24.2).
